ART PROGRAMS are NOT mandated FOR MI SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS.

- 1 Over 40% of MI students with disabilities don't graduate High School.
- 2 Dropouts face a 40% higher unemployment rate and less than 40% of young adults with disabilities are employed.
- 3 Dropouts face an 80% higher incarceration rate, and are 3X more likely to live in poverty.

A4A provides art programs for students with physical, mental, emotional, developmental, behavioral, and learning disabilities and impairments.

2018 AUCTION NEEDS

Silent & Live Auction Items are donated to raise funds for our program development.

Funds raised from your donation could help us cover some important costs!

- \$50.00 could cover admission for 1 ACCESS Monthly Outing for Teens & Adults.
- \$100.00 could provide 1 Art Escapes workshop for local students.
